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Everyone loved the pancakes. They mixed the flour, egg and water and ate them with butter and maple syrup on top. They all ate lots of pancakes!

We also learned about our BRAIN and how to protect it when they are riding bikes or other vehicles. They each took an egg and put it under a helmet and then dropped a toy on the helmet. The egg did not break (except for the one I dropped on the floor). Then they each took their egg and put it under a baseball cap and when they dropped the toy the egg smashed to pieces. They love SCIENCE experiments! Thank you to Ellis for the eggs and Beau for the helmet.

Everyone took home a recipe paper last week for parents to put their child's favorite recipe on. When you send these recipes back, we will make a book out of them.

This week our SPECIAL EVENT will be a SLUMBER PARTY on Tuesday! The children may wear their pajamas and bring a sleeping bag or a blanket. We will play musical beds, toss the

stuffed animals, and hopping on beds. We will learn about why we have to go to bed, why we have to sleep in our own bed, and about people that have to work all night and sleep all day. If the weather is bad that day and South Jeff is closed, we will have our Slumber Party on THURSDAY.

TUESDAY the Bears will begin by finding the things we HEAR. Our letter to trace is "C" and our number is "2". Our number story is Jack and Jill. They will cut our buckets and glue the number to their wells. Everyone will color two items on their paper. They will finish the story about "When I was a snowflake". We will finish a snowman that is missing one half, glue the sled dogs on their sled, and make a winter door hanger.

THURSDAY the Bears will begin by finding pictures of foods they can EAT. Our letter is "D" and our number is "2". We will work on papers about Martin Luther King for his Day on Monday the 20<sup>th</sup>. We will build a snow man for behavior and a sad-mad mouse. Our SCIENCE topic is our EYES.

Everyone will make a picture of their EYES and how to protect them from injury and from the sun.

JANUARY 21<sup>st</sup> our SPECIAL EVENT will be our ANIMAL PARADE. Each child should bring in their favorite stuffed animal for our parade. We will learn about different animals-what they eat, where they live, how they protect themselves from weather and predators. Our SCIENCE unit will be our EARS.

JANUARY 28<sup>th</sup> our SPECIAL EVENT will be making STONE SOUP and hearing the story about making this soup. Each child may bring in a carrot, a potato, an onion, etc. Items we can use for our soup. Crackers are great too. The Bears will cut up the vegetables and add them to our pot with a big foil wrapped stone in the bottom. I will bring meatballs and diced tomatoes to add.
